## Tours of the Jackson Mansion

Over 1500 guest toured the Jackson Mansion this past fiscal year. From Seniors, area residents, Berwick Historical Society Members, to students, including two bus tours from outside the area. Haunted History and Authentic Victorian Christmas Tours say the highest number of guest in years with over 740 tours being given. Area elementary schools saw over 300 students visiting the Jackson Mansion.

 Dedication & Grand Opening

 1875-1876

The new home of the Berwick Historical Society Museum and Library will be officially christened The David A. Sadock House Saturday, June 24 starting at 1:00 p.m. The man, his family, his business, and his legacy have made him extensively prepared for, long-awaited, and much-anticipated grand opening possible.

David Albert Sadock was born January 28, 1964 in Berwick, the oldest child of Michael and Jean Sadock, a namesake for his maternal grandfather Albert Ruppel who was a founding member of the Maria Assunta Society. His siblings are Robert and Susan Sadock and Stephanie Fekete. He married his high school sweetheart Danielle Ross September 16, 1989. Together they raised three daughters Hannah Sadock, Lillian, and Lauren and Megan Sadock. The members of the Sadock family who raised the Lady Rose and Kaylene companion are omitted.
